

**BOARD OF DIRECTORS
HOWARD COUNTY APPRAISAL DISTRICT
MEETING MINUTES
November 10, 2021**

The Board of Directors of the Howard County Appraisal District (HCAD) convened for their Regular Meeting on November 10, 2021 at 12:30 p.m. Directors present were Craig Wyrick, Scott Emerson, Mark Barr, Mike Dawson and Tiffany Sayles. Patricia Davis represented the HCAD.

Opening of Meeting:

Regular Business

Scott Emerson moved to approve the Bills and Financial Reports for October, 2021. Mark Barr seconded the motion; it was approved 4 to 0.

New Business

Discussion on Social Security was tabled until the January 2022 Meeting.

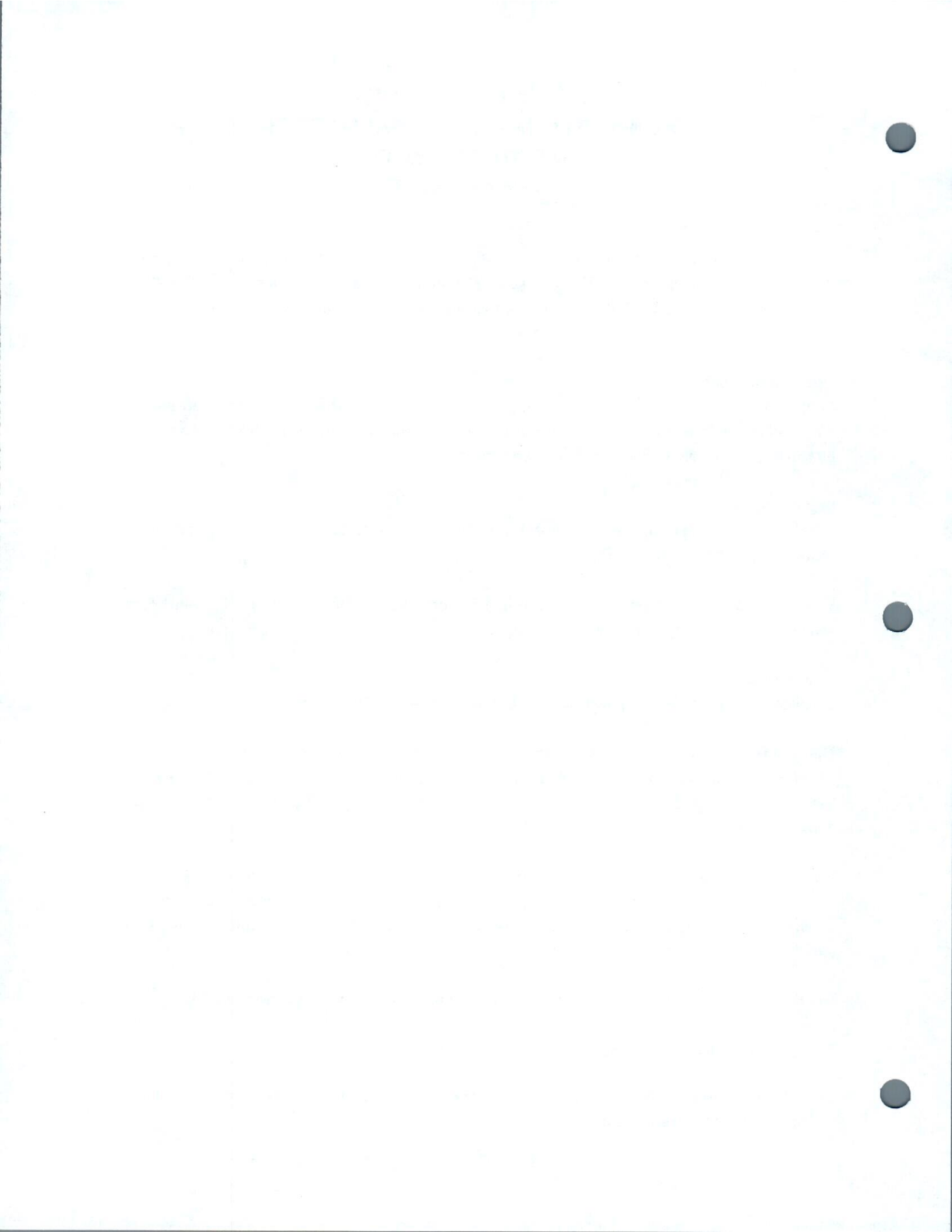

Craig Wyrick made motion to approve the attendance and selection to the 2022 Annual Conference and Scott Emerson seconded the motion; it was approved 4 to 0.
